



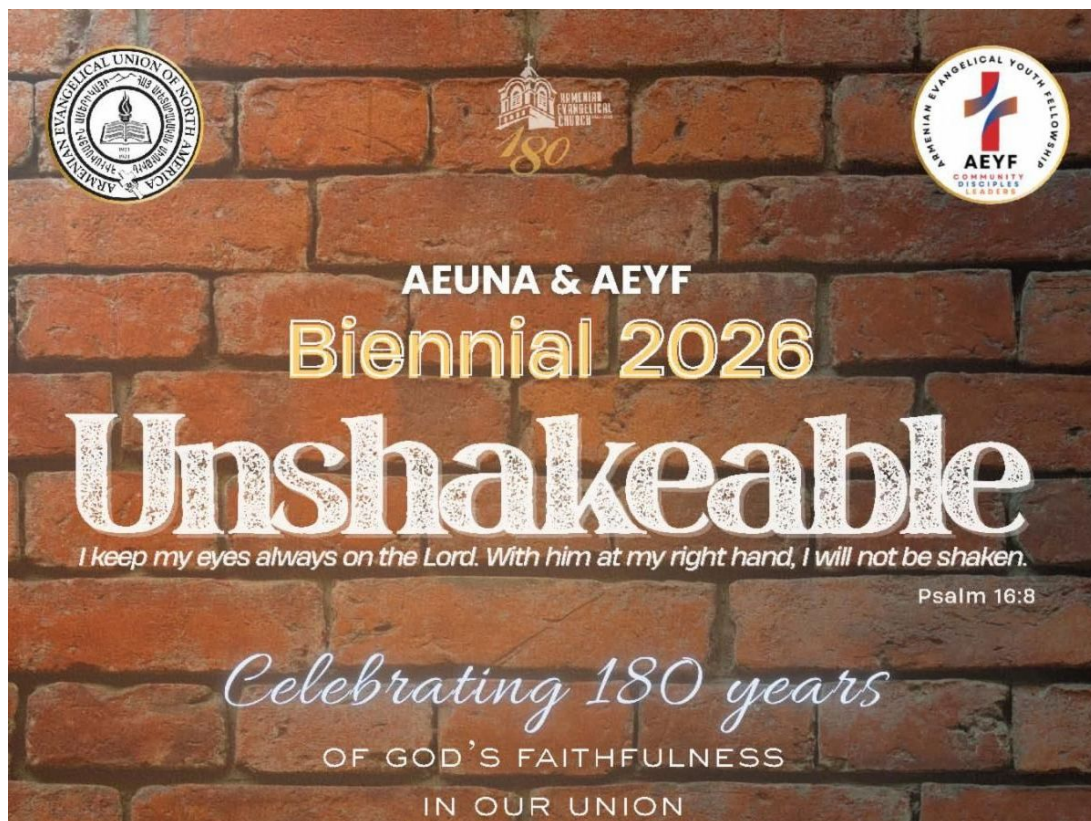

As Armenian Evangelical churches, schools, and Haigazian University respond to the ongoing and prolonged emergency situation in Lebanon, the **Armenian Missionary Association of America** is fundraising to support relief efforts, current ministries and services in greater Beirut and Anjar.

- **Operational Continuity of Armenian Evangelical Institutions**
Ensuring that our churches, schools, and university remain functional, and able to serve their communities despite challenging conditions, economically, psychologically and physically.
- **Education Support (Scholarships & Student Aid)**
Providing tuition assistance, scholarships, and emergency aid so students who are impacted by the conditions can continue their education without interruption.

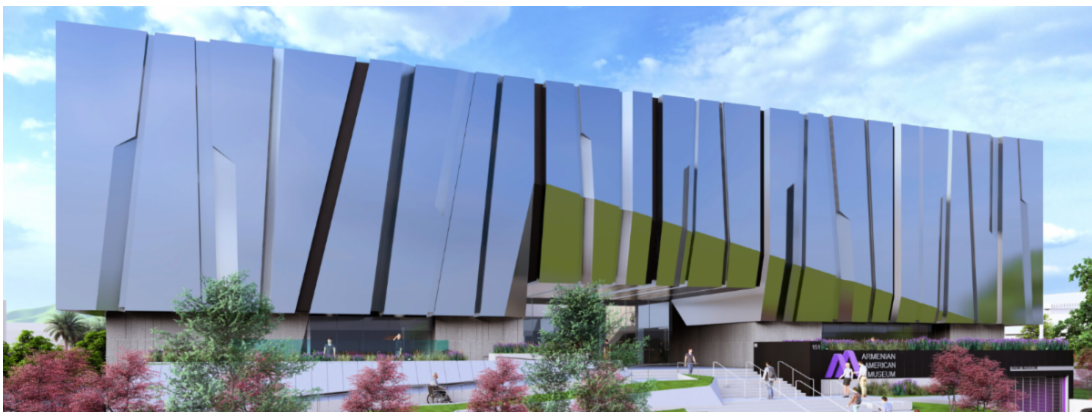

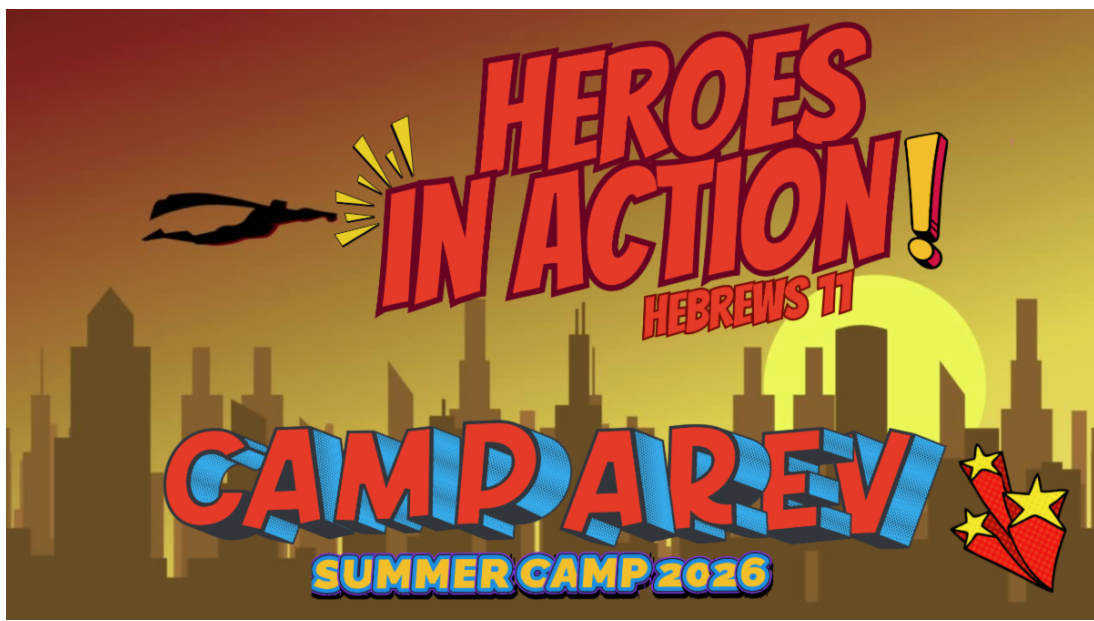
